On travel, in church, in the prayer group and even in the comfort of your bed, wherever you are with your handheld, every verse reference to the Bible will be available to you.

**Bible With You is required.**

**Bible Concordance With You** requires **Bible With You** application and is a remarkable addition for it, offering AND, OR, NOT, Wildcard, phrases searches in the Whole Bible or in specific books or groups of books.

## 2 How to Start the Application

Locate the **Bible Concordance With You** icon on the Applications screen of your Palm OS handheld. Launch the application by tapping on the icon.



## 3 Registration

### 3.1 Licenses

GMPSOFT offers the following licenses for using its products:

- 1. Trial License** – Includes all the functionality of the **Standard License** plus indication that the product needs to be registered.
- 2. Standard License** – Indicates that you have successfully licensed a GMPSOFT's product. A Standard License gives a permission to activate **Bible With You** from applications supporting Verse Show Protocol (for example **Bible Concordance With You**).
- 3. Limited License** – Indicates that you have availed of the opportunity for one limited license for a GMPSOFT's product. The **Limited License** is free.
- 4. Free License** – Indicates that you have licensed a free GMPSOFT's product.

**Bonus:** Each License ordered for *Bible Concordance With You* gives you the right to use all of the other concordance index files as well.

### 3.2 Product Registration

This fully functioning product can be registered with the help of **PADUnlock** file (**PA**lM **D**atabase **U**nlock **S**ystem). **PADUnlock** is a standard database file (.pdb) containing your registration information for each of the products you have purchased. You receive your **PADUnlock** file after you order a License for a GMPSOFT product and register it in our system database.

**Warning:** **Bible Concordance With You** requires a License for **Bible With You** application as well. Order licenses for **Bible With You** for different Bible translations from: [www.gmpsoft.com](http://www.gmpsoft.com)

1. Get your **PADUnlock**:
  - Follow the Unlock Key link in the GMPSOFT Sales Confirmation email you have received after purchase.
  - Click on **GET IT** link in your **Product Info** page.
  - Save the file on your PC
2. Install PADUnlock
  - Install **PADUnlock** database in your device's RAM
  - or on the expansion card.
3. Go to **Registration** form:
  - Launch a GMPSOFT product



- Tap on **Bible With You** bar or **Menu** button to display the form menu
- Tap on **Book**
- Tap on **Registration**

**Or**

- Draw the *Graffiti Menu Command stroke* ✓ and the letter **R** on the silkscreen

**Or**

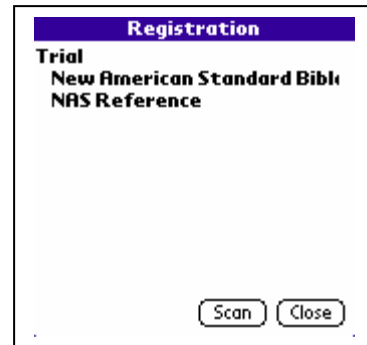
- Tap on **Register** button in the trial reminder form

#### 4. Apply your **PADUnlock** registration information:

- Tap on **Scan** button

GMPSoft products support **PADUnlock** Key protocol and use it to automatically register your products.

**Note:** The *Trial reminder* form will still appear if there is even one product with a Trial License state.



## 4 Adjusting the Preferences

1. Choose **Preferences** from the **Edit** menu
  - Tap on **Concordance With You** bar or **Menu** button to display the form menu
  - Tap on **Options**
  - Tap on **Preferences**
2. Choose search in the default Bible translation
  - Enable **Use default Bible translation** checkbox

This option will allow you to search automatically in the Bible translation selected as primary for Bible With You.

3. Text size
  - Tap on the triangle button on the left of the **Text size** field
  - Choose text size from the drop down list
4. Show Bible verse excerpt

This option provides verse excerpts for each found reference. Search words are displayed in red color in their verse context for fast orientation in the result.

### 4.1 Turn on Show Bible verse excerpt option

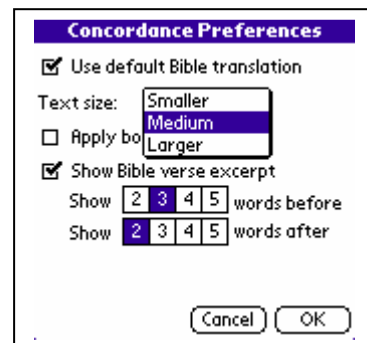
- Enable *Show Bible verse excerpt* checkbox

### 4.2 Select number of words in context to show before and after the search word

- Tap on the desired numbers in the *Show words before/after* lists

### 5. Confirm

- Tap on **OK** button



## 5 Set Search Range

You can search in a specific part of the Bible by setting a Search Range. Using selected parts of the text will make navigation in the result easier.

1. Choose **Search Range** from the **Edit** menu:
  - Tap on **Concordance** bar or **Menu** button to display the form menu
  - Tap on **Edit**
  - Tap on **Search Range**

2. Expand/Collapse the *Bible Book Tree*:
  - Tap on a group of books to Expand/Collapse books in content

3. Set the range by enabling a part of the Bible or a book.
  - Tap on the check box to change alternatively its state



Enabling or disabling a parent item will synchronize the state of all books that are contained in it.

For example, if you want to search in Books of Law and Joshua only, you have to disable Whole Bible, Old Testament and New Testament, and then enable Books of Law and Joshua.

Gray status of a check box indicates that not all child items are selected.

4. Confirm
  - Tap on **OK** button

## 6 Select Bible Translation

**Bible Concordance With You** is available for different Bible translations. Each translation works with two databases – a *Concordance*, which is an index of the words in the Bible, and a *Bible* that contains the biblical texts.

To use whole functionality of the application install both databases. However, Bible Concordance With You can also work only with the *Concordance* database.

1. Choose **Concordance** from the **Book** menu
  - Tap on **Concordance** bar or **Menu** button to display the form menu
  - Tap on **Book**
  - Tap on **Concordance**
2. Scan for Bible translations
  - Tap on **Scan**

Bible Concordance With You stores cache information about the available databases. This speeds the operation when you use memory cards.

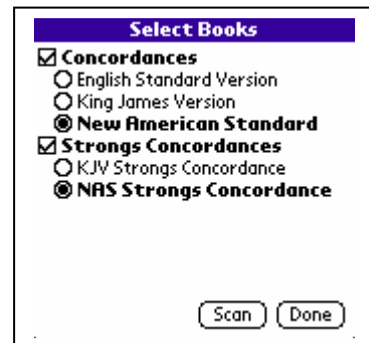
It is not necessary to scan each time. Scan when you:  
Installed new concordance(s) or bible(s)  
Deleted concordance(s) or bible(s)  
Transferred concordance(s) or bible(s) from handheld RAM to memory card or vice versa  
Moved concordance(s) or bible(s) in another folder of memory card

- i. Select a Bible translation
  - Tap on the respective field before the Bible version in the list of available Bible versions

Gray status of a version indicates one of the following:

- Concordance With You for this version is not installed (if you have installed a version after the last scan, scan again)
- Versions of Concordance and the application are not synchronized. To download latest versions, please, visit our website: [www.gmpsoft.com](http://www.gmpsoft.com)

4. Enable **Bible** check box if you want to use bible texts
  - Tap on **Bible** checkbox to change alternatively its state
5. Confirm
  - Tap on **Done** button.



## 7 Perform a Search in the Bible

### 7.1 Enter a Search Expression

1. Type one or more words, phrases or a search expression in the **Look up** field:
  - Use graffiti area or System Keyboard**Or**

You could use the Edit Search Expression form to type your expression for more convenience and when your search expression is longer than the Look up field.



2. Open **Edit Search Expression** form
  - Tap on the triangle icon at the **Look up** field
  - Tap on **edit...**
3. Type your search expression
  - Use graffiti area and the application buttons to indicate different search features:



Use buttons as a prompt for symbols indicating different search features.

4. Confirm
  - Tap on **Done**
5. Perform search
  - Tap on the binocular icon at the right bottom corner of the screen

If all the words in your search query are included in some subset of verses, you will receive as a result a list of verses in which the order of books agrees with the Bible and the verse numbers are in ascending sequence.

If you want to view verse excerpts, turn on Show Verse excerpt option.

- See Section 4 for instructions

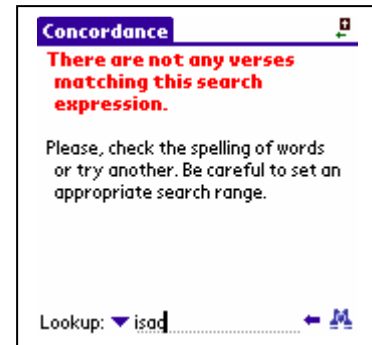
6. Force completion of search:
  - Tap on **Number of matches** found for selected search range is displayed at the top right corner of the screen.



Blue color of the Number indicates the search has finished and this is the actual number of results. If search is still in progress, the number of matches will be colored in red.

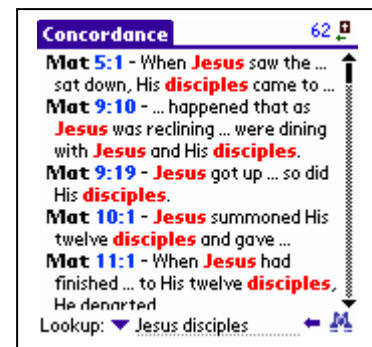
If there are no verse references found, please check the spelling of the words or try another suggestion.

**Warning:** You have to use only letters in the **Look up** field. Inputting numbers is not allowed and will cause lack of result. There are some punctuation marks used to indicate specific searches (for more, read 7.3, 7.4, 7.5, 7.6, 7.7)



## 7.2 Words Search

1. Type a word or words in the **Look up** field:
  - Use graffiti area or System Keyboard
2. Perform search:
  - Tap on the Binocular icon on the right of the **Look up** fieldThe result will be all verses containing the words no matter what their order is.



## 7.3 Phrases search

1. Search for phrases:
  - Type the phrase in double quotation marks (for example "Son of God")The search result will consist of only those verses containing the search words ordered exactly as in your query.
2. Search for two or more phrases:
  - Type the phrases in double quotation marks (for example: "Jesus Christ" "Son of God")The result will be the verses containing all phrases no matter in what order they have been typed.



## 7.4 Alternative search

This feature enables you to search alternatively for words. The result will be all verses containing any of the words you have typed in the search field:

1. Search alternatively for words:
  - Type the vertical line symbol - '|' - as a separator between the words without spaces

For example, if you type (saul|paul|timothy) without spaces, you will receive a list with the references for the words 'saul', 'paul', 'timothy' respectively, in the bible

books order.

This feature could be especially helpful when you explore parallel topics (for example, [blessing|curse](#)), or search for all appearances of an irregular verb (for example, [take|took|taken](#)), etc.

## **7.5 Wild Card search**

Use the Wild Card Search to substitute a part of the word.

1. Search with wild card:
  - Type an asterisk (\*) inside or at the end of a word to substitute zero one or more letters

For example, if you search for [find\\*](#), the result will be all the verses containing the word [find\\*](#) and its derivatives 'finding', 'findeth', 'findest' (this could be especially helpful when you search in an old English bible translation).

Substitute one or more letters inside of a word with the asterisk (for example, "[f\\*d](#)") to search for all words beginning with 'f' and ending with 'd'.

You could search for combinations like '[find\\* him](#)' and receive as a result the verses containing '[find him](#)' or '[finding him](#)'.

**Warning:** The asterisk cannot be used at the beginning of the word - for example, '[\\*ing](#)'.

## **7.6 Excluding Search**

This feature allows you to exclude certain words or phrases from your search enquiry.

1. Exclude a word or words from your search:
  - Type an exclamation mark (!) before it

For example, if you type ([!Jonathan David](#)), the result will be all verses containing the word '[David](#)' and not the word '[Jonathan](#)'.

**Note:** Look at the diagrams showing the result of search excluding the expressions to understand the behavior of Excluding Search feature:

'find !me !him' – equal to the mathematical expression  $\text{find}/(\text{me} \cap \text{him})$ '. The result contains all verses for 'find' excluding those who have both 'him' and 'me' (colored area on Diagram 1.)

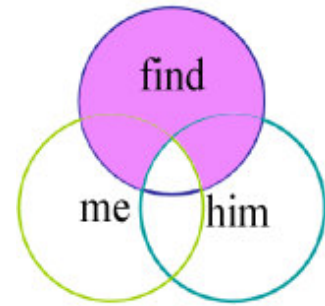


Diagram1.

'find !me|!him' – equal to the mathematical expression  $(\text{find}/\text{me})/\text{him}$ '. The result will be all verses for 'find' containing neither of the words 'me' or 'him' (colored area on Diagram 2.)

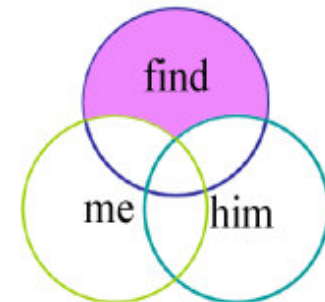


Diagram2.

2. Exclude phrases from your search:
  - Type an exclamation mark (!) before it

For example, if you type (Blessed !"David said"), the result will be all verses containing the word 'David' and not the phrase ".

## 7.7 Search Expressions

If the following seems too complicated for you, do not worry – it really is. You do not need all search features to use successfully this product. If you encounter problems using any of them or writing search expressions, just ignore them.

1. Use words and phrases in combinations:
  - Type both the phrase and word(s) for search (for example you can type: *Jesus Christ "Son of God"*)

The result will be the verses containing the exact phrase and any of the words 'Jesus' and 'Christ'.

2. Combination of features:

- Set search rules by using two or more search features in one search expression.

If you type ("[And God|Jesus saw|said](#)"), the result will be the verses containing any of the phrases - "[And God saw](#)", "[And Jesus saw](#)", "[And God said](#)", "[And Jesus said](#)".

### **Rules for using search features:**

- The Alternative Words Search and Wild Card Search could be used in combinations like (Jesus|Christ sa\*), but not in one expression (f\*ing|f\*d).
- If your search words listing is too large (as for "f\*d f\*g"), there could be a slowdown in displaying the result.
- Do not write an exclamation inside a phrase ("!David said"), but in front of it (!"David said").

**Warning:** In order to provide maximum speed of operation, Concordance With You does not check your search expressions. That is why, if you type an incorrect search expression or misuse search symbols, you will receive an incorrect result.

*Taking into consideration that there could be an unlimited number of variants for search enquiries we have not been able to check them all. Please, report to us any problems you might encounter when you search for expressions.*

## 8 Searching for Strong's Numbers

A Strong's number begins with one of the letters **H** (for Hebrew – used in OT) or **G** (for Greek – used in NT), followed by the number – **H22** - with no dividers between them – spaces or zero (H 22 or H022).

Some Strong's numbers have different modifications, indicated by a letter immediately at the end without any dividers. For example, the number **H2425** could have two modifications - **H2425a** and **H2425b**. Any modification can be indicated in the Look Up field by the '+' sign at the end - **H2425+**.

1. Activate a Strong's concordance
  - Enable Strong's concordance in the **Select Books** form (See 6 Select Bible Translation)
2. Enter a Strong's number
  - Type one or more Strong's numbers in the **Look up** field:
  - Use graffiti area or System Keyboard

**Note:** Type the exact number with its respective letter **H** or **G** in front and the letter of the modification at the end, if there is one.

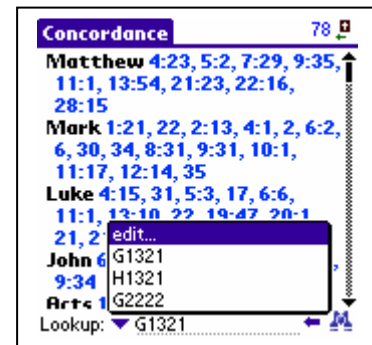
If you type **H2425+**, the result will be all verses containing all modifications of the number - **H2425** or **H2425a** and **H2425b**.

If you want to search for the exact modification, type the modification letter at the end - **H2425a**.

When you use Dictionaries in which the Strong's numbers have modifications and the exact modification is not important, it is recommended to type '+' at the end of all Strong's numbers you are searching for to ensure you will get a result.

3. Submit your search query
  - Tap on the binocular icon at the **Look up** field

If the Strong's numbers in your search query are included in some subset of verses, you will receive as a result a list of verses in which the order of books agrees with the Bible and the verse numbers are in ascending sequence.



## 8.1 Using Search Features With Strong's Numbers

Using Search features is the same as in Bible Concordance With You Gold.

You can search for several Strong's numbers, use the **Alternative search** (|), **Wild Card search** (\*), **Excluding Search** (!), **Search Expressions**.

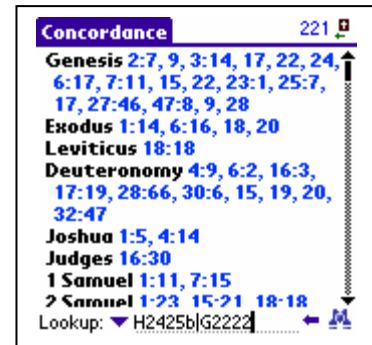
### Notes:

1. Although Wild Card Search works, it does not have much application when you are searching for Strong's numbers, as it is designed for searching for strings.

2. **Phrases Search** feature (" ") cannot be used with Strong's numbers.

For more information on how to use Search features, please, read the User Guide of **Bible Concordance With You**.

1. Type one or more Strong's numbers in the **Look up** field and the symbols of different search features
  - Use graffiti area, System Keyboard or the **Edit Search Expression** form



## 8.2 Simultaneous Search for Words and for Strong's Numbers

**Bible Concordance With You** allows you to search for both words and Strong's numbers.

**Important: Bible Concordance With You** searching for words and phrases must be installed. Get it from our website: [www.gmpsoft.com](http://www.gmpsoft.com)

1. Open Select Books form Enable a concordance and Strong's concordance
  - See 6 Select Bible Translation
  - Enable both a **Concordance** and a **Strong's** concordance
2. Enter a word and a Strong's number
  - See 1 Enter a Search Expression

The search result will include all verses containing both the word and Strong's number translated in one of its meanings

**Note:** For information about the Strong's numbers search, please, refer to the User Guide of Bible Concordance With You (...oS)

**Note:** Mixed search allows you to find the verses in which an original Hebrew/Greek word has been translated as a particular word:

For example, Strong's number **H776** has several translations - *common (1), countries (15), countries and their lands (1)...*, etc.

To find the verse, where **H776** has been translated as '*common*':

- Launch **Bible Concordance With You**
- Select **Concordance** from the **Book** menu
- enable both a **Concordances** and a **Strongs Concordance**
- type **h776 common** in the **Lookup** field
- the result will be - Lev 4:27



## 9 Visualizing Bible Verses

**Bible Concordance With You** supports *Show Verse Protocol* that allows it to launch **Bible With You** reader directly from the search screen to display the verses from the result.

1. Launch **Bible With You**
  - Tap on the desired chapter/verse number in the result.
2. Return to **Concordance With You**
  - See Section 12. for instructions

## 10 New Search

1. Clear previous search:
  - Tap the back arrow on the right of the **Look up** field
2. Change the Search Range if needed (see section 4.2).
3. Type new Search Expression.



## 11 Most Recent Searches


In order to go back and see past search results:

1. Show the Most Recent List of searches
  - Tap on the triangle button on the left of the **Look up** field
2. Select an item from the list
  - Tap on it in the list. You can scroll up and down using the corresponding arrows



## 12 Show Verse Protocol

**Bible Concordance With You** supports Show Verse Protocol which allows it to launch PDA **Bible With You** reader in order to display a verse from the result.

1. Visualize a verse with **Bible With You**
  - Tap on the verse number in the search result
2. Return to **Bible Concordance With You**
  - Tap on the fish icon  in the *Headline bar*
